Benton and Franklin Counties is a high-risk area for human trafficking. Local factors including teen pregnancy rates and the poverty level — both of which are higher than last year —can increase the risk of human trafficking in a community. Approximately 75% of the people who have been trafficked and are receiving support from our local nonprofits are 24 or younger; and many of them lack formal education, professional skills, have mental health concerns, and are recovering from abuse.

While it's not easy to share the difficult challenges that affect our community, there is hope.
